

## **COVID-19 Policy**

## **COVID-19 EXPECTATIONS:**

- All persons attending rehearsals should undertake regular LFT tests and should not attend rehearsals if their test is positive.
- If you become symptomatic, or feel unwell, please do not attend rehearsals until you are back to full health. Please let us know of your absence in advance.
- On arrival at rehearsals, all persons will have their temperature taken by a committee member. If the temperature reading is above 38°C then you will be sent home.
- Mask wearing is not mandatory at rehearsals but if anyone wishes to wear a mask then they will be able to do so. If the government guidance changes on mask wearing then we will adhere to the new guidelines.
- All persons attending rehearsals are encouraged to regularly wash their hands and/or use the hand sanitiser provided.
- All persons attending rehearsals must be able to answer NO to the COVID-19 screening questions.

## **COVID-19 SCREENING QUESTIONS**

Everyone who attends rehearsals must be able to answer NO to the following questions:

- 1. Do you currently have any symptoms of COVID-19: a high temperature, a loss or change in taste or smell, a persistent cough?
- 2. Have you or anyone in your household had a positive COVID-19 test in the last 5 days?
- 3. Are you or anyone in your household awaiting the results of a COVID-19 PCR test?
- 4. Have you been advised to isolate in the last 10 days?

Please note: as the new Omicron variant can be similar to mild flu symptoms including a runny nose, headache and fatigue, we would advise that you do not attend rehearsals if you feel unwell.
