CODE OF CONDUCT for all those involved in YOUNG GENERATION



The Young Generation is a registered charity run by volunteers.

Trustees:

will be bound by the rules relating to Trustees

Committee Members, Chaperones and Volunteers:

- 1. are expected to demonstrate consistently high standards of personal conduct, ethics and behaviour and to uphold public trust in the Young Generation both within and outside rehearsals.
- 2. are expected to treat young members of the Young Generation with dignity, building a relationship based on mutual respect and at all times observing proper boundaries.
- 3. are expected to have regard for the need of safeguarding young peoples wellbeing in accordance with the Young Generations Child Protection Policy.
- 4. are expected to show tolerance and respect of the rights of others.
- 5. are expected to uphold fundamental British values, including democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty and mutual respect, and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs.
- 6. are expected to ensure personal beliefs are not expressed in ways that might exploit young peoples vulnerabilities.

Young Generation Members

- 1. are expected to behave with respect to cast members, committee members and the production team in the Young Generation and to work together towards a successful production.
- 2. are expected to attend all rehearsals, once cast in a show, unless prior permission for absence has been obtained.
- 3. Bullying, or any form of threatening or discriminatory behaviour, will not be tolerated.
- 4. Involvement with illicit substances, smoking and consumption of alcohol during rehearsals and performances are not permitted.
- 5. Prompt payment of subscription is important. Non-payment of a due subscription before entering the theatre during performance week will result in exclusion from the production.

Chaperones:

will be bound by the rules relating to Chaperones and Committee Members (see above)

Volunteers:

have a valued and respected place within the Young Generation and are expected to adhere to the same high standards as Committee Members (see above)
